

Madison Scarf Beanie



Materials:

1 skein I Love This Cotton Yarn (Hobby Lobby) or Berroco Comfort
Size 8 circular 16 inch needles
Size 8 double point needles
Stitch marker

Cast on 72 stitches and connect in the round placing a stitch marker to show the beginning of your round.

Knit every row for nine (9) rows.
Next row: YO, K2tog entire row

Continue knitting every row until hat measures 6" from cast on.

Start Decrease: (Change to double point needles when circumference is too narrow for circular needles.)

Rnd 1: (Knit 7, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 2: and every even number round: knit plain around entire row
Rnd 3: (Knit 6, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 5: (Knit 5, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 7: (Knit 4, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 9: (Knit 3, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 11: (Knit 2, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 13: (Knit 1, K2tog) around entire row
Rnd 15: *Knit 2, together

Only 2 stitches remain in each section. Break yarn, leaving 12". Thread onto tapestry needle and loosely thread through remaining stitches. Thread through a 2nd time and pull tightly to close remaining hole. Thread to inside and stitch in place to secure. Weave in and out of a few stitches, clip remaining yarn.

Choose a ribbon of your choice and thread through YO row and tie into a bow.

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
